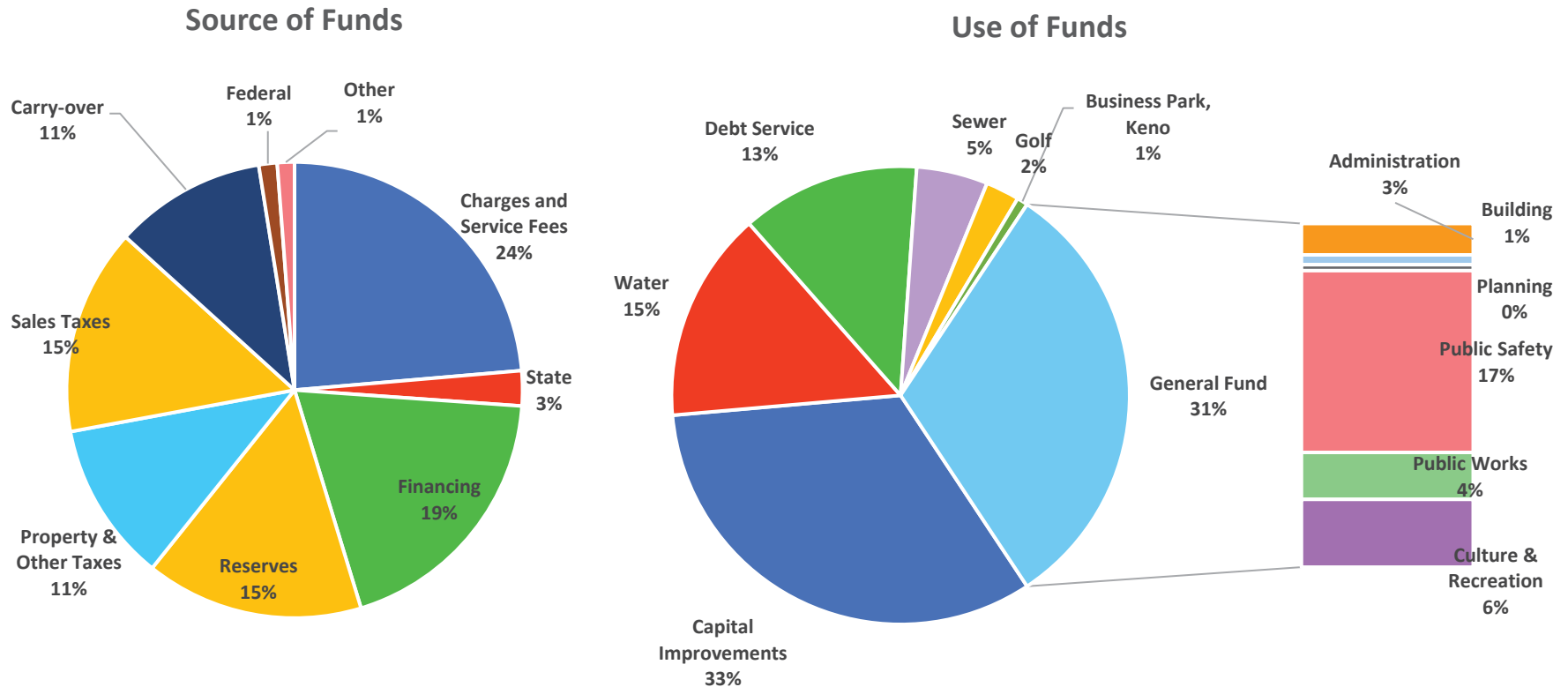


# The City of Papillion's Budget – Fiscal Year 2019-2020

## Source and Use of Funds



Fiscal year 2019-2020 projects slightly more than \$116 million in funding from four major sources. The City's property tax revenue accounts for only 10.3% of total revenue. The City's tax levy has remained stable at .451923 per \$100 of valuation. Charges and service fees include water, sewer, EMS, golf and other permit and license fees.

The general fund is the main operating fund for the City and accounts for the largest use of revenues at just over \$33 million. Police and fire represent the largest category within the general fund budget. Capital improvement projects account for the largest use of revenues, and include \$14.3 million in street improvements. Also included in capital improvement projects is \$19.3 million directed toward improvements financed by the additional one half percent sales tax increase, which include a new community center.
