I recognize that the issuance of this right to occupy public right-of-way permit shall not grant approval to violate any of the provisions of the applicant's Master Agreement to Occupy public rights-of-way, city or zoning ordinances enforced by this jurisdiction, and state or federal law; and that this permit shall not prevent the City Engineer or his/her designee from requiring the occupation of City right-of-way to be in compliance with such regulations. This permit shall become null and void if the installation, operation, or maintenance of a communication system within the City right-of-way has not commenced within 180 days from date of issuance or if work has commenced then stopped for more than 180 days. This permit is issued for the express purpose of work stated on this application and shown on the approved plans. Any changes to the plans that affect area or scope of work shall be approved by the City Engineer or his designee prior to any work within the City right-of-way and may require another permit application. No permit fee refunds are allowed if work has commenced or if work has not commenced and more than 180 days has elapsed after issuance date. The City is not responsible to determine actual locations of property lines. The property owner or person doing the work is responsible finding property lines.
