



Sunday, July 14th 2019

On Sunday, July 14th, the City will be hosting its 15th Annual Papillion Mayor's Triathlon. For safety reasons we will be utilizing Schram Road, 108th Street, HWY 370 and 96th Street for the bicycle part of the race. In an effort to reduce the amount of motor vehicle and bicycle interaction, it will be necessary to close or limit traffic around Walnut Creek Lake and Recreation Area. Based on where you live or where you may be traveling the morning of July 14th, please note the following roadway restrictions:

- Race starts at 7:30 am, Road Closures start at 7:00 am
- Event ends at 11:00 am and Course will shut down
- **Walnut Creek Area** will be closed from 6:00-11:00 am
 - No vehicular traffic allowed into the South Entrance from Schram Road or the East Entrance from 96th Street from 6:00 am – 11:00 am.
 - Anyone already in the campground will be able to exit if needed during the race. Motor vehicle traffic will only be allowed to go south on Turkey Road in the north bound lane, and then east on Schram Road. Please watch for bikers traveling south on Turkey Road and West on Schram Road.
- **Schram Road West Bound Lane from 96th Street to 108th Street will be closed from 7:00-10:30 am.**
 - For those of you living in cul-de-sacs on the north side of Schram Road we apologize for any inconvenience. While it is our hope to minimize the amount of traffic into and out of your cul-de-sacs with signs and barricades, we realize you may need to come and go during this time period. Should you need to leave your cul-de-sac while the barricades are in place we ask one thing; Motor vehicle traffic will only be allowed to go east on Schram Road. Staff will be on hand to guide you where to go. Please watch for bikers traveling west on Schram Road.
- **108th Street North Bound Lane from Schram Road to HWY 370 will be closed from 7:00-10:30 am.**
 - For residents living in the South Brook Neighborhood, we apologize for any inconvenience. While it is our hope to minimize the amount of traffic into and out of your neighborhood with signs and barricades, we realize you may need to come and go during this time period. Should you need to leave your neighborhood while the barricades are in place we ask one thing; please watch for bikers traveling north on 108th Street. Traffic will be allowed to go south to Schram as usual and north to HWY 370 utilizing the middle turn lane.
- **HWY 370 Southern East Bound Lane from 108th Street to 96th Street will be closed from 7:00-10:30 am.**
 - Bikers will be traveling east on HWY 370.
- **96th Street South Bound Lane from HWY 370 to Schram Road will be closed from 7:00-10:30 am.**
 - For those of you living in cul-de-sacs on the west side of 96th Street we apologize for any inconvenience. While it is our hope to minimize the amount of traffic into and out of your cul-de-sacs with signs and barricades, we realize you may need to come and go during this time period. Should you need to leave your cul-de-sac while the barricades are in place we ask one thing; Motor vehicle traffic will only be allowed to go north on 96th Street. Staff will be on hand to guide you where to go. Please watch for bikers traveling south on 96th Street.

Please use caution and watch for cyclists and spectators throughout the Walnut Creek Lake and Recreation Area between the hours of 6:00 am and 11:00 am.
